Performing a Traceroute on a Mac

A traceroute traces the path from your computer to your website, showing the routers that the data passes through. In order to perform one on a Mac:

- Open the Applications folder, and click on Utilities
- Double-click Terminal
- Type: traceroute your_domain.com

* Note: replace your_domain.com with your actual domain name.
